Exam room	Healthcare workers	Physical examination of patient WITH respiratory symptoms.	Respirator (e.g. N95), Gloves Eye protection. For aerosol generating procedures: private room with closed door, N95, gown, glove, eye protection.
		Physical examination of patients WITHOUT respiratory symptoms.	PPE according to standard precautions and risk assessment medical mask and eye protection
	Room Turnover	After and between consultations with patients WITH respiratory symptoms.	Respirator (e.g. N95) Gloves Eye protection or gown (if risk of splash from organic material or chemicals). Rooms POST-Aerosol generating procedure: close room for 2 hours then cleaning as above.
	Visitors	Visitors attending an appointment with COVID-19 patient	Face Mask
Waiting room	Patients WITH respiratory symptoms.	Any	Provide medical mask if tolerated. Immediately move the patient to an isolation room or separate area away from others; if this is not feasible, ensure spatial distance of at least 6 feet from other patients.
	Patients WITHOUT respiratory symptoms.	Any	Medical mask, eye protection
Administrative areas	All staff, including healthcare workers.	Administrative tasks	Medical mask, eye protection
Triage	Healthcare workers	Preliminary screening by clinical staff to determine COVID-19 risk status not involving direct contact.	Maintain spatial distance of at least 6 feet OR Droplet precautions.
	Patients WITH respiratory symptoms.	Any	Maintain spatial distance of at least 6 feet. Provide medical mask if tolerated by patient.
	Patients WITHOUT respiratory symptoms.	Any	Medical mask, eye protection
