## Home Visiting Staff For Management of Suspected/Confirmed COVID-19 Patient

Setting	Target Personnel or patients	Activity	Type of PPE or procedure
Patient's Home or Assisted Living Facility	Healthcare Workers	Providing direct care to patients + for COVID-19.	N95 respirator, gown, gloves, eye protection (face shield).  Patient wears a mask. Place infection control kit into the home.
		Providing direct care to a patient that has been identified as exposed to COVID-19 (on quarantine) and is <b>SYMPTOMATIC</b> .	N95 respirator, gown, gloves, eye protection (face shield).  Patient wears a mask. Place infection control kit into the home.
		Providing direct care to an asymptomatic patient with a family member that is + for COVID-19 or under investigation for COVID-19.	N95 respirator, gown, gloves, eye protection (face shield).  Ask the family member to isolate themselves in another room, if possible. If they must be present for the visit, have the family member/caregiver wear a mask.
	Family Members or Caregivers	Present at the time of visit.  **Of note, please ask the family member/caregiver to isolate themselves in another room, if possible.	Mask to be worn by family member/caregiver if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Family member/caregiver is + COVID-19</li> <li>Patient is + COVID-19</li> <li>Has been in contact with anyone that is + for or under investigation for COVID-19</li> </ul>
	Patient with Respiratory Symptoms but: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>is not under investigation for COVID-19</li> <li>is not + for COVID-19</li> <li>Has not had any contact with anyone + for or under investigation for COVID-19</li> </ul>	Any	Healthcare worker wears a medical mask, face shield and gloves.  Patient wears a mask.
	Patient or family member/caregiver identified as exposed to COVID-19 (on quarantine) but <b>ASYMPTOMATIC</b>	Providing direct care to patient and family member/caregiver present at the time of visit.	Healthcare worker wears a medical mask, face shield and gloves. Patient and family member/caregiver wear a mask.

\*\*\*N95 guidelines as updated 1.20.21. We are also following universal masking guidelines (updated 11/11/20). Wear your mask and face shield for all patient interactions. Wear a N95 respirator with any patients that are COVID-19 + or under investigation for COVID-19. Please remember to ask all patients to wear a facial covering or mask during home visits, as tolerated. \*\*\*
