MH Outpatient:

- Adult, Child and Youth -Individual sessions
- Personalized Recovery Oriented Services -Individual and classes available through phone.
- Assertive Community Treatment-Individual sessions
- School Based Health Centers- continue to offer medical and mental health services for the following designated sites: Edison, Charlotte High, John James Audubon, Freddie Thomas, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.
- Home Based Crisis Interventions-offering crisis services to families when a child is at imminent risk of hospital or out-of-home placement. (585)-922-8040

Psychiatric/Crisis Services:

- Comprehensive Crisis Programs continue to be operational and fully staffed.

- Psychiatric Inpatients remain operational with capacity (RGH, St Marys, Newark, Clifton Springs)

CD Programming

- Outpatient programming -Individuals, Groups and Medication Assisted Therapy
 - Rapid admission for new clients is available also so that people can attend right away/same day if desired. Includes availability of both groups and individual sessions via telephone.
- Referrals for higher level of care if needed including access to our inpatient and outpatient detox programs that are fully staffed and operational based on medical necessity.
- Women's Community Residence-remains open and operational
