

Rochester Regional Health Screening Questions

As the COVID-19 pandemic has evolved, we have learned more about what symptoms present in patients with the virus and as a result, Rochester Regional Health has added more questions to the RRH Daily Pass and visitor/patient screening questions.

Have you had any of the following symptoms since your last screening, or in the last 24 hours, that are new or unusual for you?

- Loss of sense of taste or smell?
- Chills or fever of 100F (37.8C) or higher?
- Sore throat (not due to allergies)?
- Feeling like coming down with an illness (Ex. Fatigue or muscle aches)?
- Unusual headache or eye pain?
- New cough or change in your cough?
- New or worsening shortness of breath (difficulty to breath)?
- Abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or loss of appetite (skipping a meal)?
- Contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 or have been tested positive in the last 14 days (except healthcare workers exposed at work)?
