Abstract In the 1980s, Dr. William M. Valenti became an early leader in the

treatment of HIV/AIDS patients in Rochester, NY. The collection

documents his career as a physician and as founder of Community Health

Network, Inc., a not-for-profit community based medical facility for HIV care. The collection also documents the global medical response to the emergence of HIV/AIDS and changing cultural attitudes towards those infected with the virus. The collection includes published books

and periodicals, newspaper clippings, and a small amount of graphic and

audiovisual material.

Biographical note

Dr. William M. Valenti was born in 1945 and grew up in the Rochester suburb of Irondequoit, graduating from Eastridge High School in 1963. After earning a B.A. from the State University of New York at Buffalo in 1968 and M.D. from the Medical College of Wisconsin in 1972, he returned to Rochester to complete postdoctoral training in infectious diseases at the University of Rochester. He joined the faculty of the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry in 1975.

When AIDS emerged as a public health crisis in the early 1980s, Dr. Valenti became one of the foremost local experts on the disease. He worked closely with local media to provide authoritative information, appearing frequently in print and television features on AIDS. In 1989, Dr. Valenti and Dr. Stephen Scheibel co-founded Community Health Network, Inc., a not-for-profit community based medical facility for HIV care in Rochester. By 2009, Community Health Network (by then known as AIDS Community Health Center) would have a staff of 60 serving 600 patients. In 1995, Dr. Valenti became the Medical Director of Rochester Primary Care Network, a consortium of 11 community health centers providing medical care to underserved populations. On January 1, 2010, AIDS Community Health Center merged with AIDS Rochester to form Trillium Health, expanding its services to provide primary, non-HIV related health care to the LGBTQ community in the Rochester region.

As of 2016, Dr. Valenti serves on the staff of Trillium Health as Senior Vice President for Strategic Advancement and Staff Physician. He is a Clinical Associate Professor of Medicine at the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry, and a fellow of the Infectious Diseases Society of America. He serves as Chair of the Infectious Diseases Subcommitte of the Medical Society of New York and recently served as Chair of the Hepatitis C Guidelines Committee for the New York State Department of Health.

Over the course of his career, Dr. Valenti has participated in numerous professional groups, including the Monroe County Medical Society, the New York State Health Department AIDS Institute, the American Medical Association, Association for Professionals in Infection Control, Physicians Association for AIDS Care (PAAC), and the HIV Medicine Association. He is a past editor of NUMEDX.com, The AIDS Reader/Medscape, and the American Journal of Infection Control. He has published more than 150 peer-reviewed articles, book chapters, and scientific abstracts.

Scope and Contents

In addition to documenting Dr. Valenti's professional career, the collection provides background on the progress of HIV/AIDS treatment, the global and local (Rochester, NY) response to AIDS as a public health crisis, and changing cultural attitudes towards patients. The collection includes materials related to Rochester-area AIDS organizations with which Dr. Valenti was associated, including AIDS Rochester,

Rochester Area Task Force on AIDS, Community Health Network, Inc., and the AIDS Resource Library at Monroe Community College.

The collection is comprised of both published and unpublished materials. Published materials include books, journals, journal articles, pamphlets, brochures, newspaper clippings, training materials, conference proceedings, and other formats. Unpublished materials include working copies of some of Dr. Valenti's professional writing projects, correspondence, awards, and yearly desktop organizers. There are also a small number of photographs, slides, and audio and video recordings.

The bulk of the materials date from the time period 1985-1999, with a smaller amount of material from earlier and later dates.

Arrangement

No usable original order was apparent when the collection was received, so the current arrangement was imposed during processing.

The collection has been arranged into five series. Series 1: William M. Valenti biographical and career information (which consists of subseries Awards, Conferences, Correspondence, Curriculum vitae, Lectures, Newspaper clippings, Organizers, and Publications); Series 2: Professional associations (Medical Society of the State of New York, New York Academy of Medicine, New York State Department of Health, New York State Department of Health AIDS Institute); Series 3: Research material (Books, General interest periodicals, Journal articles, Journals, Newspaper clippings, Pamphlets/miscellaneous print material, and Slide presentations); Series 4: Rochester-area AIDS organizations (AIDS Resource Library, Community Health Network, Rochester Area Task Force on AIDS, and Miscellaneous organizations), and Series 5: Audiovisual material (Sound recordings and Video recordings).

Custodial History

The collection was transferred to the Rochester Medical Museum and Archives c. 2006, after being housed for an unknown number of years at Monroe Community College. A small amount of material has been added to the collection between 2006-2016, mainly newspaper clippings.

Processing Information

Metal fasteners were removed and replaced with plastic clips. Materials were housed in acid-free, lignin-free folders. Newspaper clippings were copied onto standard office copier paper. Original folder titles have been retained when possible.

Materials that were originally gathered and arranged in three-ring binders have been rehoused in folders and the binders discarded. In the case of slides, which are found in both Series 1 and Series 3, the graphic materials are housed in slide storage boxes while the accompanying text documentation is housed separately in document boxes.

Scope and Contents

This series documents Dr. Valenti's professional career, including his education, teaching career at the University of Rochester, awards received from professional groups and local (Rochester, NY) organizations, conferences attended, and publications. Materials consist of published and unpublished writings; correspondence; curriculum vitae; desk organizers showing day-to-day meetings and activities; lecture slides; topical subject files consisting of both published and unpublished materials; and newspaper clippings, many of which quote or interview Dr. Valenti as an expert on HIV/AIDS.

The slides found in this series consist of slides organized by Dr. Valenti into lecture presentations. Some of the slides appear to have been created by Dr. Valenti, while others appear to have been selected from slide presentations published by private companies (such as drug manufacturers), by government organizations, and by other academics.
